## Snack Credit System

- ATB has a snack credit system, where parents can send a lump sum through cash or check and choose how many snacks a day their child can purchase. We highly encourage the use of the Snack Credit Account as it keeps children from having cash on them, which can be lost or taken.
- Purchases will be recorded daily so that there is a record of what each child buys.
- When a child's funds get low, a note will be sent home alerting the parents to send more money, if they like.
- If using cash, please be aware that due to our limited snack time, we will only accept paper bills and quarters in an effort to get the children served more quickly. Dimes, nickels, and pennies are NOT accepted.
- Since PK3 does not eat snack with the rest of ATB, they will receive the regular ATB snack but will not participate in the Snack Sale.

Please make sure that snacks are easy to open and not excessively messy and that drinks have tight lids or are disposable.
